**In the matter of Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) and Annual Tariff Proposal(ATP) for the second control period in respect of M/s DELHI CARGO SERVICE CENTER PVT. LTD. M/s (DCSC) for providing Cargo Handling Services at Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi.**

1. M/s Delhi Cargo Service Centre Pvt. Ltd. (DCSC) is one of the Cargo Handling agencies appointed by Delhi International Airport Limited (DIAL) for carrying out Cargo Handling (CH) at Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi. The Authority, vide its MYTO Order No. 02/2017-18 dated 11.05.2017 decided to adopt 'Light Touch Approach' in respect of the DCSC for Cargo Services at IGI Airport for determination of tariff for Second Control Period. Subsequently, the Authority also determined the Annual tariff for FY 2016-17 and FY2017-18 wherein an increase of 7% was allowed as requested by the party. The Authority vide the following Orders allowed AOs/ISPs to continue with the existing tariff till the determination of tariffs for Second Control period:
  - a) Order No.50/2015-16 dated 31.03.2016.
  - b) Order No. 11/2016-17 dated 29.09.2016.
  - c) Order No. 19/2016-17 dated 31.03.2017.
  - d) Order No. 43/2017-18 dated 28.03.2018.
2. a) M/s DCSC vide their letter dated 02.02.2018 submitted their ATP for FY2018-19 with proposed average increase of 34% on the existing tariff. M/s DCSC has submitted the audited balance sheet for FY 2016-17 and unaudited balance sheet for FY 2017-18. M/s DCSC submitted the Annual Compliance Statement (ACS) for the FY 2016-17 and Provisional Annual Compliance Statement(ACS) for FY 2017-18. M/s DCSC also submitted the Concession Agreement entered with DIAL, also Key User Agreements for examination of the Authority. M/s DCSC also submitted the evidence/minutes of the stakeholder consultation conducted on 07.11.2017 for the proposed tariff increase of 34% for the year FY2018-19. M/s DCSC has submitted the Capital Work in Progress (CAPEX) and their capitalisation report for the FY2018-19, Actuals and Projections of CAPEX for the Second Control Period. Calculations on Aggregate Revenue Required (ARR) by M/s DCSC for FY18-19, FY2019-20 & FY2020-21.



- b) i)** The Authority considered the submissions made by M/s DCSC and issued a Consultation paper No. 14/2018-19 dated 16<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2018 wherein, the Authority proposed that M/s DCSC may be allowed to charge tariff with an increase tariff of 25% on the existing tariff for FY2018-19 and 20% for FY 2019-20 and 3% for FY 2020-21.
- (ii)** The Authority noted that M/s DCSC's Return on Average RAB i.e. -2% for FY 2016-17 and the turnover/loss % in FY 2016-17 is -2%.
- (iii)** The Authority observed that M/s DCSC incurred losses in FY 2016-17 & FY2017-18 mainly due to increase in minimum wages and considered the shortfall while calculating the Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) for FY2018-19, FY2019-20 and FY2020-21.
- 3. a)** The Authority sought evidence based written feedback, comments and suggestions from stakeholders on the above mentioned consultation paper (CP) by 05<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2018. The Authority vide email dated 17.08.2018, informed the same to all concerned stakeholders on their registered email IDs. In response, The Air Cargo Agents Association of India (ACAAI) and Delhi Customs Clearing Agents Association (DCCAA) submitted their comments on the proposal made by the Authority. No other stakeholder has commented on the Consultation Paper. The Authority vide Public Notice No. 18/2018-19 dated 06.09.2018 displayed in its website the comments of the above mentioned stakeholders. सत्यमेव जयते

**b) Views of the Authority on Stakeholder comments:**

- i.** DCCAA vide their letter dated 05.09.2018 commented that the Custom Facilitation Fee was not discussed in the stakeholder consultation meeting held on 07.11.2017. The Authority considered the comments of DCCAA and is of the view that the Custom Facilitation Fee is one among the operating cost/expenditure which has to be borne by the cargo operator as the mandatory services designated by "Handling of Cargo in Customs Areas Regulations, 2009". AERA determines tariff by quantifying all the financials on actual basis and fixes the maximum tariff/increased tariff, which will lead the independent service provider (ISP's) to earn reasonable revenue making his operations viable.
- ii.** ACCAI vide their email dated 03.09.2018 commented that the tariff increase proposed by the Authority for FY2019-20 and FY2020-21 should be in consultation with the trade bodies. The Authority considered the comments of ACCAI and is of the view that the increase proposed in the CP is based on the ARR calculation required for FY2018-19 and not to overburden the tariff increase on the users, the Authority carried forward the tariff increase to FY2019-20 and FY2020-21. The details of the calculations are already submitted in the above mentioned CP. However the Authority will direct M/s DCSC to conduct the stakeholder consultation with its users and trade bodies on the proposed increased tariff of 20% in FY2019-20 and 3% for FY2020-21 and the increase would be applicable/effective after user consultation. In addition to this M/s DCSC should submit the Annual Compliance Statement as



directed/described in AERA Guidelines to monitor any unreasonable profit in FY2019-20 and FY2020-21. Further, the new charges are introduced in the tariff card on the addition of new services by the cargo operator. However, the Authority observed that the charges such as Repacking Charges and other new charges added to the tariff card are optional in nature and are available to users only on demand. The same has been declared by M/s DCSC and the same would be notified in the tariff card. The definition of Normal Delivery Charges and Express Delivery Charges as defined by M/s DCSC is also incorporated/ notified in the noting section of the tariff card.

## **ORDER**

Upon careful consideration of the material available on record, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1) (a) of the AERA Act, 2008, hereby orders that:

- (i) The Authority, vide its MYTO Order No. 02/2017-18 dated 11.05.2017 decided to adopt '**Light Touch Approach**' in respect of the DCSC for Cargo Services at IGI Airport for determination of tariff for the duration of Second Control Period (01.04.2016 to 31.03.2021).
- (ii) The Authority is of the view that 'the Guidelines' need not be followed in a routine manner. Further even in 'Light Touch approach,' the Authority examines the margins, the growth of profit and Return on RAB to ensure that extraordinary profits do not accrue to the service provider and that the ultimate customer is not burdened with higher tariffs as the latter does not have any say in the User Agreements.
- (iii) Considering the negative (a) Return on RAB, as well as (b) Profit Margin, as detailed in Consultation Paper, the proposal of M/s DCSC to increase tariff for Tariff Year FY 2018-19, is found admissible by the Authority. The party has asked for increase of 34% for FY2018-19. However, in order to avoid over burdening the users with a steep increase in a single Tariff Year, the Authority, approves staggering the increase over three Tariff Years i.e. an increase of 25% in FY2018-19, followed by a 20% increase in FY2019-20, and, 3% increase in FY 2020-21.

Further, the increase in tariff approved for FY 2019-20 & FY 2020-21, as above, shall be allowed subject to M/s DCSC duly holding Stakeholders Consultation with its Users and Trade Bodies, and, on submission of such evidence to AERA. Accordingly, M/s DCSC is allowed to charge the approved tariff from the date of issue of the order up to 31.03.2019 of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Control Period for Cargo Handling Service rendered at Delhi International Airport, Delhi, as per **Annexure-I**. The increase in rate for FY2019-20 and FY2020-21 will be notified after stakeholders Consultation in this regard.

- (iv) Tariff determined as above will be maximum tariff to be charged. No other charge is to be levied over and above the approved tariff.
- (v) M/s DCSC should submit Annual Compliance Statements duly audited as per



the AERA Guidelines annually and conduct the Stakeholders consultation with the users on the proposed Annual Tariff Proposals (ATPs) in future before approaching AERA for tariff determination.

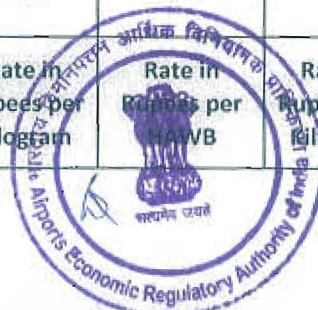
